At this meeting we hope to have fuller details of the results from our second survey. We have been amazed by the strong response to this survey with well over 200 questionnaires returned. Thanks to all who took the time to return them.

As usual everyone from the Parish is most welcome as we continue to develop the Plan which will have an important effect on shaping the future appearance of our neighbourhood.

We are looking for volunteers to take part in a series of on-ground descriptions of the plan area in the spring. If enough people come forward then we can split the area into small, manageable sections so no-one will have to go very far from their own house! If you will have an hour or two to spare do let any member of the steering group know. This survey will result in a document (officially called a Village Design Statement) which will describe our area and is one of the requirements in the plan which has to be presented to the authorities. We are attempting to show that as many of our residents as possible are involved in the decisions that will be made in the next few months.
