

Carlyon Parish Neighbourhood Plan

The next public meeting of the Steering Group will be held on

Tuesday November 24th

after the Parish Council meeting which starts at 6pm. This will be a virtual meeting. Any member of the public wishing to attend the meeting should obtain the joining details from the Clerk no later than 12.00 noon on 23rd November. For security reasons no person will be admitted to the meeting without prior notification to the Clerk that they wish to attend.



The draft Neighbourhood Plan will be discussed by the Parish Council preceding this meeting. They will vote on the Plan and will decide to approve it or not. If approved this will signal the start of a consultation period which will last some 10 weeks. The Plan is inspected and commented on by officials of Cornwall Council and is also circulated to stakeholders operating in the area.

Most importantly we are also asking all residents and business owners to look at the Plan and comment on it as they see fit. These observations will be incorporated in the Plan before it goes to an Inspector for a final decision followed by a Parish-wide referendum on the Plan's adoption.

You should have received the first Parish newsletter which contains details of how everyone in the Parish can see the Plan, either on-line or by hard copy. The re-worked Plan and the Appendices are now available on the Parish Council website www.carlyon-pc.gov.uk. Go to the Neighbourhood plan pages via the tab on the left hand side of the home page and follow the Quick Links tabs to get to the submitted material.
