

# Carlyon Parish Neighbourhood Plan

The draft policies – central to our Development Plan – have now been drawn up. Following some excellent guidance from the County Council professionals we are reworking a few areas for what we hope will be the final presentation to the Council. Once finalised we will be posting them on the Carlyon Parish website, [www.carlyon-pc.gov.uk](http://www.carlyon-pc.gov.uk) for perusal and public comment. Once on the website go to the Neighbourhood Plan pages via the tab on the left hand side of the home page. You will also find links to both the first and second surveys there.

Kath Statham, the expert from Cornwall Council, has been commissioned to conduct the main stages of the Local Landscape Character Assessment, a necessary part of the Plan. We have also engaged a specialist from the Cornwall Wildlife trust to provide Wildlife Resource maps for the Parish.
