



West Crinnis Field – Public Rights of Way Update

5th February 2026

Following a positive meeting with Brend Hotels, Carlyon Parish Council is pleased to report that a new proposal has been offered to provide a Public Right of Way on West Crinnis Field aligning with the community's priorities.

The proposal offers that the existing permissive path **through the coastguard gate will be designated as a public right of way**. Additionally, it includes the establishment of a **western route across the field** to connect with the South West Coast Path, as well as an **eastern route** providing further access to the coastal path.

During an Extraordinary Council Meeting held on 4 February, the new proposal was formally presented to both council members and members of the public in attendance. Councillors subsequently **voted unanimously in favour of supporting the proposal**.

Subject to Cornwall Council's ratification, a Public Path Order will now be made. This order will contain the detailed map of the proposed paths and will go out for a **28 day public consultation**. We encourage public support for the proposal to ensure that the permissive paths, historically used for generations, are established as permanent public rights of way.

The parish council expresses its sincere appreciation to the community for communicating their preferences regarding the public right of way, and to Brend Hotels for considering those preferences in their decision-making.
