

Carlyon Parish Neighbourhood Plan

The next public meeting of the Steering Group will be held on

Tuesday October 27th

after the Parish Council meeting which starts at 6pm. This will be a virtual meeting. Any member of the public wishing to attend the meeting should obtain the joining details from the Clerk no later than 12.00 noon on 26th October. For security reasons no person will be admitted to the meeting without prior notification to the Clerk that they wish to attend.



By the date of this meeting you should be able to see the draft Neighbourhood Plan which now incorporates comments by officers at Cornwall Council. You should have received the first Parish newsletter which contains details of how everyone in the Parish can see the Plan, either on-line or by hard copy. We hope as many of you as possible can find the time to look at the Plan and pass on your comments about it. These comments will then be taken on board before the final version goes to Cornwall Council for their perusal before it goes to an independent Inspector and subsequently to a Parish-wide referendum.
