Intention to Purchase Tregrehan Chapel



On 21st May 2024, Carlyon Parish Council voted unanimously to purchase Tregrehan Chapel as a community hall for the parish. Further to this, on 16th July 2024, the parish council unanimously voted in favour of a Resolution to Borrow to help fund the purchase. The details of the purchase, borrowing and running costs are as follows:

The purchase and annual running costs will be:

•	Purchase Price:	£150,000
•	Running costs:	£5,000 pa

The purchase will be funded as follows:

•	Taken from reserves:	£75,000
•	Public Works Loan:	£75,000

The annual Public Works loan repayment and running costs will be:

•	Total annual cost:	£10,461
•	Running costs:	£5,000 pa
•	Repayment of Public Works Loan:	£5,461 (25 years at 5.42%)

We have been reserving an average of £11,667 per annum towards the cost of a community hall. This reserve will instead be redirected to pay the Public Works Loan and the building's running costs. Consequently there will be **no increase to the council tax precept** as a result of the purchase.
